Introduction

- The agenda was reviewed and accepted.
- The notes from the June 21st meeting were reviewed and approved with one minor revision.

October Open House

- Some feedback was received from CAC members with regards to the upcoming Open House.
- It was agreed that this open house would be less elaborate in terms of presentations and there is no need for TERA or the Evaluation of Exposure Team to be present.
- The hours will be from 4:00 – 8:00 p.m. with a single presentation at 6:30.
- The comment period remains open (until October 15, 2010).
- The slightly revised presentation has been circulated and commented on.
- A poster board regarding the key elements of the risk management plan has been prepared.

Risk Management

- HBMS has engaged AECOM for a community outreach program.
 - The proposal will be reviewed on October 4. Comments on the proposal will be accepted.
- A TAC meeting will be held following the Healthy Flin Flon noon hour meeting and before the Open House starts. Teleconferencing will be available for those not coming into town.
- An updated timeline document was circulated prior to this meeting.
 - The short turn-around time between HBMS submitting details of the risk management plan to the government and the final comments on the plan prior to implementation was discussed and accepted.
 - It was confirmed that the follow-up exposure study is currently planned to be a blood lead study only. Ethics approval will again be required. The timeline should be amended to “dates to be determined” as opposed to actual dates for the follow-up lead study (see action #182).

CAC Meeting

- The next CAC meeting has been set for October 28, which is as soon as possible following the close of the comment period.
- The focus of the meeting will be the detailed risk management plan.
 - AECOM plans to engage the CAC for input into the delivery mechanisms to be used for the risk management plan.

 - The Health Fact Sheets and FAQs will be referred to from the soils study website (see action #183 & #184).
 - An exposure study Fact Sheet is required (see action #185 and #186)
 - The above documents should take care of all of the questions.
